VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

Potato Bar Runner

Texas Roadhouse on Indy's northwest side donates our post-ride potato bar. This volunteer needs to be able to drive to I-465 and Michigan road to pick up. As the store is not yet open, we will have a phone number for the cook, so you can call when you arrive,

Snack stop Volunteers

Snack stop instructions:

If you have a sign board... put up the sign board.

Set up table and chairs. The chairs are for you!

If you have a bench, set up the bench for the riders.

If you have a bike stand, set up the bike stand and let the riders know they can use it for repairs if needed. Put pump and blue shop towels near the stand.

Put up the feather flag. This is what will catch the riders' attention and alert them to your location. Place near curb, where riders turn to snack stop.

Open the tubs and inspect the inventory. Use the table cloths on the tables. Use tape if the wind is an issue.

Use tape to attach a trash bag to the corner of the pop up.

Find the chalk and decorate the road / sidewalk near you... "Spokes Riders Rock" or "Cancer Sucks"... or something like that... be creative.

Place the Gatorade pump bottle next to the water jugs.

Get water from the gas station when you need more water than what was provided. If you are at LOVES, talk to the Subway people for water

Put generous samples of all food provided out for the riders to see. If you have smoothies, take them out early so that they are thawed in time for the riders. Keep the popsicles in the cooler and display the sign that we have popsicles and offer them to riders. Keep scissors nearby to cut them in 1/2.

Pickles! Yes, riders love pickles. Some may want to drink the juice. We have small cups for them to drink the pickle juice. Use a ladle to serve the juice in the cups.

Let riders know that restrooms are inside and we have permission to use them.

Look in the tubs **frequently** to remember what you have available (first aid kit... tools, tape, cookies)

If there is a crash, and people need the first aid kit, please fill out an incident report. (Paperwork found in your tub) Get as much information as possible. The incident report is in the side pocket of the tub... along with extra maps. Call the Ken (317-840-7774) to arrange pick up if they can't ride any more.

VALET SERVICE

If you are at the first snack stop and riders are wearing jackets or arm warmers that they want to take off... offer them the coat check service. They put their items in the provided zip lock bag and use the sharpie to put their name on the bag. Also... have them write the distance they will be riding so we will know what time to have their

items returned to the finish area for them to pick up. Call the sag to come and pick them up about 30 minutes after the riders have left.

MOST IMPORTANTLY!

Have fun! Fun is also contagious! If you have music... play it! Dance to it! Enjoy life to the fullest, because you are helping make a big difference in a lot of people's lives today!

What should you bring with you?

- Upbeat music that can be played and enjoyed by all. (Probably not heavy metal or rap).
- A Hat, sunglasses, sunscreen
- A lawn chair if you have one.
- You will be getting a T-shirt.
- We will have snacks at the snack stop, but if you require any special food, bring it.
- Bring something to help you pass the time. There will be sometimes where the snack stop will be swamped with riders... and then other times when you are sitting and watching the grass grow. Feel free to bring something fun to enjoy the time. A book, a hula hoop, a game to play.
- You might want to bring a back-up external battery for your phone.

SNACK STOP 1

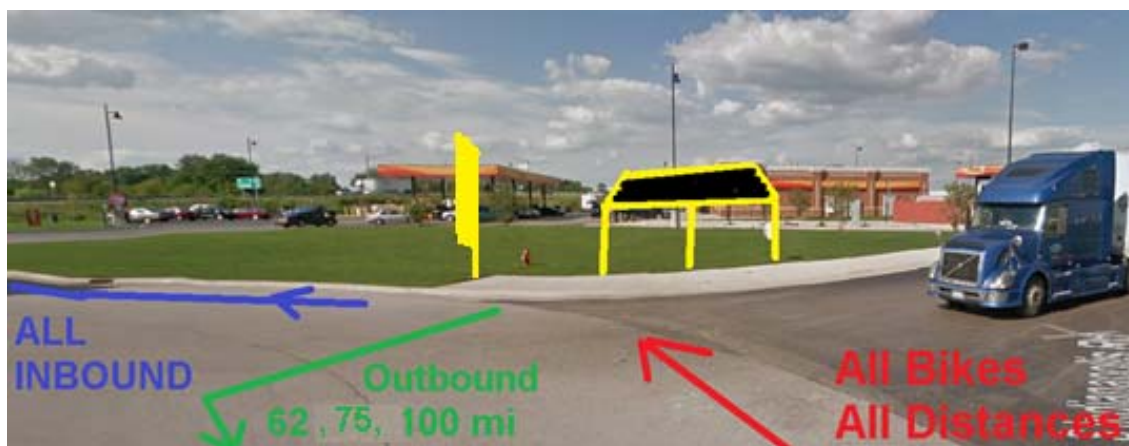
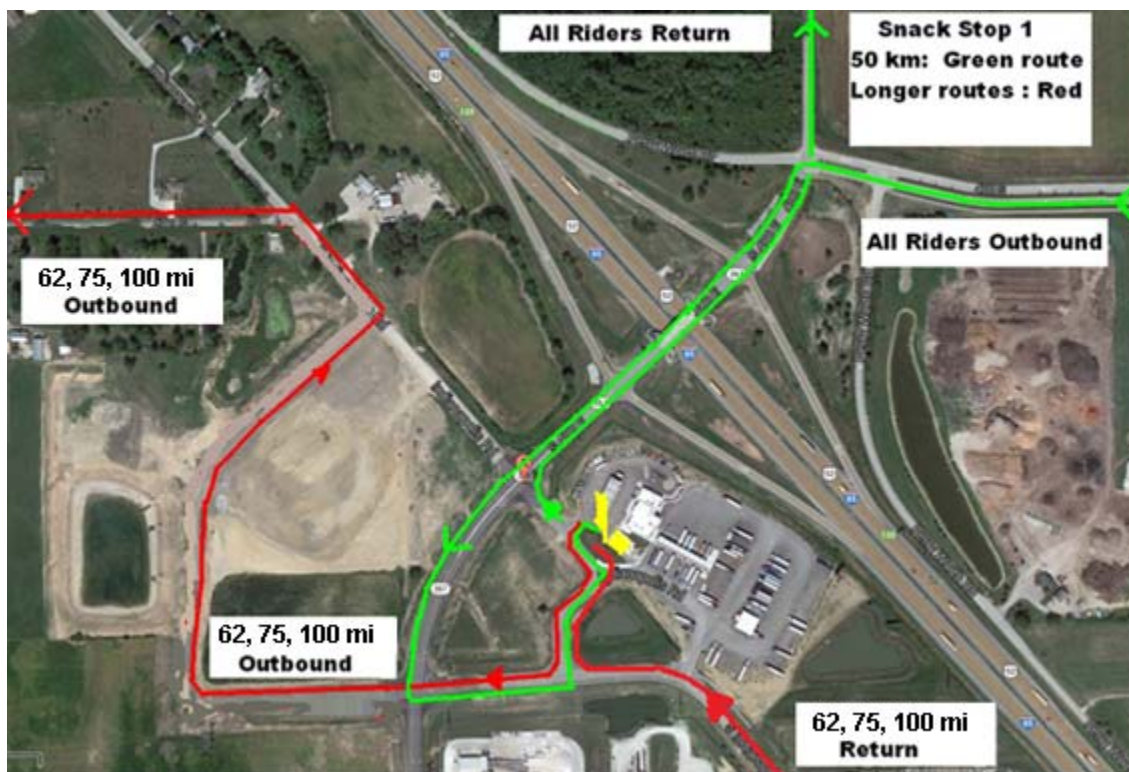
DIRECTIONS: From Lebanon

TRAVEL TIME : 15 mins

Go south on 39 (SR 334) to I-65

Go south on I-65, Turn right on 267

Loves is on left, off of Indianapolis Rd



SNACK STOP 2

DIRECTIONS: From Snack Stop 1 near Whitestown

TRAVEL TIME : 20 mins

head Southwest from Loves or the 267 overpass

Turn Left (south) on SR267 and go about 6 miles to 1000 N

Turn Right (west) on 1000 N, and go 4 miles to N 275 E

Turn Left (south) on N 275 E and go 2.5 miles

Stop is on right, just past I-74
